

Checklist - Competition Appointments

Please submit the following to the RVC or SVC per JR 9.03, JR 9.04, JR 9.22, JR 9.23

- A completed "Application for Judging Appointment" form.
 - ❖ Download this form at <http://www.usfigureskating.org/content/jc08.pdf>
- Trial Judge sheets for every event trialed at approved competitions (nonqualifying and qualifying).

For each competition trialed, include the following:

- EID (Element Identification) score.
 - ❖ Multiple Element Identifications will be averaged.
 - ❖ The candidate must achieve the passing % on Element Identification (EID). If not, the application & file are not submitted for an appointment. There are no exceptions to this.
 - Trial Judge assignment sheet.
 - Trial Judge worksheets for each event trialed with event evaluation box completely filled out.
 - Tracking Sheet (Excel spreadsheet) with all computations completed by the monitor.
 - IJS "Judges Details per Skater" for each skater in event trialed. See below for example**
 - Evaluation from the JET/RVC/SVC.
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- Judges assignment sheet (Form 104) for each non-qualifying competition judged.
 - ❖ Refer to the Judges Committee Guidelines.
 - Judges assignment sheet (Form 104) for each qualifying competition judged.
 - ❖ Refer to the Judges Committee Guidelines.
 - IJS Judges School certificate(s).
 - Candidate is reapplying for the appointment (must wait at least 6 months before reapplying).
 - ❖ Resubmit all of the above to the RVC or SVC.
 - ❖ Candidate must continue to have activity towards the appointment during the waiting period.
