Nonqualifying Theatre on Ice Competition Judge Appointment Guidelines

Judging Appointment Requirements	Silver Singles & Pairs or Dance Test or higher Must be at least a Regional Competition Judge in S/P, Dance or Junior Sectional Judge in SYS
Guidelines to Obtain Nonqualifying TOI Competition Appointment	To apply for this appointment, the candidate must complete <b>the following:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. <b>Judges School &amp; Test:</b> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a. Attend a judges school approved by the Judges Committee for that purpose within 4 years prior to application <u>and</u></li> <li>b. Pass a proficiency test consisting of both written and oral sections with a minimum passing grade of 80%.</li> </ol> </li> <li>2. <b>Trial Judging:</b> Trial judge a minimum of one National Theatre on Ice Competition</li> <li>3. Theatrical/musical background (experience in theatre) is desirable, but not required.</li> </ol>
Requires favorable endorsement of judging peers and NVC Guidelines may be modified by the NVC or Chair

National Novice Theatre on Ice Competition Judge Appointment Guidelines

Judging Appointment Requirements	Must be at least a Sectional competition appointment in S/P or Dance or at least a Senior Sectional Competition Judge in SYS
Judges School	Attend a judges school approved by the Judges Committee for that purpose within 4 years prior to application.
Judges Promotional Exam	Pass a proficiency test consisting of both written and oral sections with a minimum passing grade of 80%.
Guidelines to Obtain Appointment	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Judge nonqualifying Theatre On Ice events with a minimum of three or more teams (must submit 104 with application)</li> <li>2. Satisfactorily trial judge a minimum of one National Theatre On Ice Competition.</li> <li>3. Theatrical/musical background (experience in theatre) is desirable, but not required.</li> </ol>
Requires favorable endorsement of judging peers and NVC. Requires positive action by the USFSA Board of Directors. Guidelines may be modified by the NVC or Chair

Judging Appointment Requirements	Must be at least a Sectional Competition Judge in S/P or Dance or at least a Senior Sectional Competition Judge in SYS and be a Novice National Theatre On Ice Judge
Judges School	Attend a judges school approved by the Judges Committee for that purpose within 4 years prior to application.
Judges Promotional Exam	Pass a proficiency test consisting of both written and oral sections with a minimum passing grade of 80%.
Guidelines to Obtain Appointment	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Judge nonqualifying Theatre On Ice events with a minimum of three or more teams (must submit 104 with application)</li><li>2. Satisfactorily trial judge a minimum of one National Theatre On Ice Competition.</li><li>3. Theatrical/musical background (experience in theatre) is desirable, but not required.</li></ol>
