	One spin in one position with no change of foot (minimum 5 revolutions)**			
STEPS	One step sequence – must be visible and identifiable and use almost the full ice surface

*May be performed as solo jumps, or as part of jump combinations or sequences, but no jump element may count for more than one of the jump requirements. **Both spins may have a flying entry.  - One triple jump is permitted. It may be performed as a solo jump or in one of the jump combinations or sequences, and it fulfills the requirement of a single or double jump. - Extra elements may be added without penalty. - Two different elements may be reskated, if necessary.
