The following elements are required:

JUMPS: Maximum of six jumping elements including the following requirements:

- ___ 1. One Axel jump
- ___ 2. One double jump: double Salchow or double toe loop
- ___ 3. One jump combination consisting of two single jumps (no turn or change of foot between jumps)
- ___ 4. One jump combination consisting of either one single and one double jump or consisting of two double jumps (no turn or change of foot between jumps)

SPINS: Recommended two to include:

- ___ 1. Flying spin (minimum 5 revolutions in position)
- ___ 2. Spin combination consisting of at least one change of foot and at least one change of position (minimum of 4 revolutions on each foot)

STEPS:

- ___ One step sequence (straight line, circular or serpentine) fully utilizing the ice surface

Extra elements may be added without penalty. Two different elements may be retried, if necessary.
