



Technical Notification 17

Pairs Committee – Rule Clarification – Definition of Pair Spin Combination in the Junior & Senior Short Program

In ISU Communication No. 1445, the definition of the pair spin combination in the short program was modified slightly.

This technical notification is to advise that Rule 4041 C. 5. b. should read as follows:

b. Pair spin combination: The pair combination spin must have at least one (1) change of foot and one (1) change of position of both partners with not less than eight (8) revolutions in total (at least two (2) basic positions or their variations must be executed by each partner). The change of foot and the change of position may be made either at the same time or separately, but both partners must change feet simultaneously. The rotation must be continuous and no stop is permitted except a short stop when changing direction. The pair spin combination must not be commenced with a jump.
