



## ***Technical Notification 18***

### **Ice Dancing**

#### **1. Adult Pre-Silver & Bronze Dance Event– Rulebook Correction on Test Eligibility.**

It has come to attention of the Dance Committee that Rule 4495 and Rule 4500 have the incorrect test eligibility rules printed in the 2007-08 Rulebook.

The test eligibility rules are as follows:

#### **Adult Pre-Silver Dance Event**

Both partners must have passed at least one standard, adult or masters pre-silver dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one standard, adult or masters silver dance.

#### **Adult Bronze Dance Event**

One partner must have passed at least one standard, adult or masters pre-silver dance; the other partner must have passed at least one standard, adult or masters bronze dance. Neither partner may have passed more than one standard, adult or masters silver dance.

**2.** In all instances of the Adult dance event test eligibility rules; the reference to tests to be passed shall be consistent in their meaning of any of the following types of tests “standard, adult or masters.” Rules 4480 and 4491 do not make this distinction.
