

Technical Panel Official Activity Requirements to Maintain Active Status

March 2019

All Disciplines and Levels

An official certified only as a Nonqualifying Video Operator is not subject to these requirements.

Education Requirements

1. Technical Panel Education Requirement (TPER) in discipline(s) completed by deadline as determined by TPC each year.
2. Viewing the current **Technical Panel Webinar** in discipline(s).

Event Activity Requirements

Service as technical official at a minimum of one Standard Track Non-qualifying or Qualifying competition from April 1, 2019 thru May 30, 2020 including five event segments.

An event segment requires 6 or more skaters in that segment. Exceptions may be made to the segment requirement for dance, pairs and synchronized officials, where there are fewer opportunities for activity.

Eligible **competitions** include:

- US Collegiate Championships
- Regional, Sectional and US Championships
- National Qualifying Series
- Nonqualifying (Standard Track)

One event segment will be accepted from the following events:

- Pre-Juvenile
- Excel Senior
- Adult Masters Junior-Senior

Event Requirements for Officials Holding Appointments in More than One Discipline

- Service in one area of certification within S/P/D will also qualify for another within S/P/D (e.g. TS for DO, Singles TS for Pairs TS, TC for TS.)
- Service as S/P/D DO will also qualify for SyS DO, and vice-versa.
- Service as S/P/D TS or TC does NOT qualify for SyS TS or TC.
- Video Operator activity does NOT count as TS, TC or DO activity in any discipline.

It is the responsibility of all officials to maintain records of technical panel activity including the **name of competition(s) and the 104**. If during the competition there have been changes to your assignments, ask the chief referee for a final version of the 104 on the last day of competition. It is also important to keep any other supporting documents such as a **certificate of attendance** from a technical panel seminar or school.
