Advancement

All teams that earn <u>advancement by placement</u> at the sectional championships will receive an email confirming their advancement from U.S. Figure Skating no later than 8:00 p.m. ET on Monday, January 29.

Teams will have their registration advanced from the sectional events to the championships on this date. No additional registration steps are required, however your team will be responsible for submitting additional forms and information within a very tight timeline. Please read all details of this packet carefully to assure your team completes all required steps.

Housing Information

All teams are required to book housing through U.S. Figure Skating. Teams will be staying at the Orleans Hotel and Casino attached to the Orleans Arena. Any teams who do not stay within the event room block will be subject to penalty. All teams eligible for advancement should have submitted the housing request form by January 28.

Practice Ice Sales

Official practice ice (OPI) is included with advancement for all teams and will appear in your EMS profile after the team is advanced.

Unofficial practice ice (UPI) sales will be a two-step process:

- Step 1: Purchase credits for the number of desired UPI segments in EMS. Save your invoice for submission with scheduling preferences in Step 2.
- Step 2: Provide UPI scheduling preferences on the Mandatory Form. You must upload the invoice for the purchase of your credits from EMS to this form with your preferences.

UPI segments will be available for purchase in 10-minute segments for \$125/segment. Ice will be available beginning the morning of Tuesday, Feb. 20 through the morning of Saturday, Feb. 24.

There is NO GUARANANTEE that you will be assigned the number of sessions that you request. Every effort will be made to accommodate as many teams as possible before assigning extra ice to any one team. Refunds will only be issued if segment requests cannot be accommodated.

Orleans Arena Bag and Prohibited Items Policy

All spectators or teams entering the building to watch (without skate bags) will enter the arena through Gate A attached to the Orleans Hotel and parking garage.

Credentialed attendees that access through the team entry at Gate B will not be subject to this bag policy but all bags will still be searched.

Parking Information at the Orleans Arena

There is ample parking surrounding the Orleans Arena. A bus pull-off is located in front of Gate B. Buses are welcome to park anywhere they are able in the lot.

Any team or spectator cars should park in the Orleans Arena parking garage or the Orleans Hotel and Casino parking garage.

Credential Pick-up & Check-In

Prior to accessing the arena for the first time, teams must pick up their credentials. Accreditation is located inside of Gate B, the main team entrance into the arena.

Due to the size of the accreditation space, we ask that one representative from the team pick up the athlete credentials and distribute outside of the arena or at the hotel prior to the full team coming over to the arena for any reason.

Coaches and Team Managers will need to check themselves in as a form of ID is required as compliance must be verified.

Accreditation will begin at 7:30 a.m. on Wednesday, Feb. 21. Detailed hours of operation will be provided in the final information packet.
