## OBITUARIES



### BARNETT

Ronald W. Barnett, an ice dancer who taught skating for many decades, died peacefully in his sleep on the evening of May 23, 2025, at St. Lukes Hospital in Ketchum, Idaho.

Ron was born in London, England, on May 27, 1930, to William Samuel Barnett and Jessica Caroline Barnett. He had two siblings, Babs (1 year older) and Brian (11 years younger.) He attended private schools throughout his youth,

learning to play the clarinet in his teens. Eventually, this led to playing duets with his brother-in-law, Chris.

Ron was a child during the war in England and remembered the many times he was woken in the night and marched to the shelter as bombs exploded around him. When morning came, the family would emerge from the shelter to see what houses were left standing.

At the age of 18, Ron went into the Army. At the time there was still conscription in England, and he was called to do two years of military service. The Army branch he was posted in was the REME, which stands for The Royal Electrical Mechanical Engineers.

After basic training he was sent to Egypt. He played clarinet in the Army band and completed his two years of service. Soon after leaving the Army, he began working nights in an engineering factory and spending afternoons at Queens Ice Club in Bayswater learning to skate.

He was coached by Sheila Boyle and eventually completed his gold medal status for ice dancing in both England and the United States.

Ron married Sheila and both served on the instructional staff at Queens Ice Club, Princeton Skating Club and Sutros in San Francisco. They had three children: Maria, Peter and Scott. Although their marriage ended, they remained close friends.

In September of 1979, Ron married Julie Pugh. They met in Sun Valley in 1978, when Julie asked if he could partner her for the silver free dance test. He said yes. They had one child, Tiffany. Together they coached at various rinks in Chicago.

In 1992 they relocated after accepting an offer to run the skating program in Jackson, Wyoming. In 2003, they returned to Sun Valley Idaho to live full time. They continued to teach skating and enjoyed the many social events that go along with being part of a large skating community.

Ron loved conversation and enjoyed sharing stories with family and friends. He had an amazing ability to make new friends everywhere he went. He loved visits from family and adored his grandchildren, always making special memories for them. In 2023, he was thrilled when he got to meet his great-granddaughter.

His other hobbies included building. He often made shelves for the house and planters for the garden, along with constructing decks for two different homes. He also had a love for airplanes and flying.

In his later years, he often said, "I have no regrets. I've lived a wonderful life."

Ron is survived by his wife Julie, brother Brian, children Maria, Peter, Scott and Tiffany; grandchildren and great-granddaughter. We always wanted Ron to write a book about all his adventures, the people he met and the stories surrounding them all. ## BURGE

Dr. Harland L. Burge, Jr., a national judge, president of the Los Angeles FSC and first vice president of the United States Figure Skating Association, passed away on April 11, 2025.

Harland, a leader of strength and integrity, died in his home in Laguna Hills, California.

His skating career also included serving as a team leader in Budapest, Hungary, in March of 1988.

He was born July 22, 1932, in Colorado Springs, Colorado, into a ranching family of nine children. The family heritage is of the Franklin and Kellys of Tennessee, one of the first families of Tennessee since 1793 related to Benjamin Franklin.

Harland left for college at age 16 to the University of Colorado at Boulder where he received his bachelor's in engineering. Marrying his college sweetheart, Ruth Ann, they left for Penn State University where he acquired his master's in mechanical engineering. Soon after, he joined the Navy with rank of Lt. Junior Grade and led a team of Seabees in Adak, Alaska, completing engineering projects in the Northern Hemisphere. Harland was an intricate part of the USA nuclear program in the 1950s.

Moving his young family to California, he worked in the aerospace industry at Rocketdyne and TRW designing the Apollo engines for the lunar landing modules for the moon landings. He was called upon as part of the team of aerospace experts to help Apollo 13 return to earth after their oxygen was depleting.

During this time, Harland achieved his Ph.D. in rocket engineering at UCLA. He continued his love of country for years, serving in the National Guard.

When the aerospace industry declined in the 1970s, he created a new career in law, obtaining his law degree at Loyola-Marymount in his 40s. For 48 years, he handled several well-known cases in California, including the longest trial in state history which he won.

When his three daughters started figure skating, Ruth Ann and Harland became judges in the sport. They learned the rules, the requirements and helped other families navigate this intriguing sport. Both were nationally ranked judges.

Dad would wake us at 4:30 every morning, feed us, pack us in the car for the 30-minute drive to Burbank, California, for practice before school. Then he would travel to TRW in Redondo Beach, California, and afterward go to law school at Loyola-Marymount.

My mother and father loved this sport and poured their time into helping young skaters accomplish their dreams. Several lived in our home. Many were touched by my parents' direction, wisdom and generosity.

I never could have accomplished being an Olympian without him at my side.

Harland's legacy lives on in his family and friends across the nation that knew him as a strong, kind and wise individual. They always knew they could turn to him for help or advice when needed. He truly was of a great generation and one of a kind. We all enjoyed his wit, humor and quirky mischievous smile.

His memory is honored and upheld by his surviving daughters Wendy and Roxann, Kelly (deceased), his grandson James, his granddaughter Rachel and great-granddaughter Sarah.

His story is one of strength, integrity and perseverance — a life that will inspire many to strive for their very best and fulfill their dreams that God has directed them too. He will be in our hearts forever. Job well done Dad.

## SHIPLEY

Paul (Jerry) Arnold Shipley, a longtime judge and cofounder of Tri-State Prime Timers, passed away at his home on April 13, 2025. He was 94.

Jerry was born Nov. 21, 1930, in Charleston, West Virginia. His parents divorced and remarried other spouses shortly after, and he was raised by his loving grandmother Bertha May Shipley.

He went to college at University of Charleston, and then Virginia Polytechnic Institute (now called Virginia Tech), from which he graduated majoring in biochemistry. After graduation, Jerry moved to Cincinnati and worked for US Industrial Chemical Company, where his career spanned until retirement. One of his notable achievements and successes was as co-inventor for the popular liqueur, peach schnapps. Ironically, he himself was not much of a fan of it.

In Cincinnati, Jerry developed an avid interest in figure skating. After participating and competing as a skater specializing in ice dancing, he became a figure skating judge, a hobby he continued with dedication for more than 50 years, including eight of those as an international skating judge. He retired from judging recently. In 2024, Jerry was recognized as an honorary figure skating judge for his lifetime dedication and contributions to the sport by the U.S. Figure Skating.

In 1997, Jerry co-founded Tri-State Prime Timers (TSPT). He has remained active in the club, including serving on its board many times. Through TSPT, he has made many significant friends.

Jerry is survived by his longtime companion of almost 40 years, Michael Ma. He and Michael were married by their good friend Rev. Ted Richmond. He deeply appreciated his friends from TSPT, U.S. Figure Skating and other aspects of his life. He particularly enjoyed the friendship and support of two special friends, Michael Scott and Chris Harvey. Michael Scott, in particular, has been of immense help to Jerry and Mike.
