

2025-2026 SYNCHRONIZED SKATING TEAM ENVELOPE CRITERIA

Per U.S. Figure Skating Rule ICR 5.07, the Synchronized International Subcommittee has the responsibility to determine and approve the criteria to name synchronized skating teams to the Team Envelope.

The Team Envelope, which is a funding model only, consists of teams who are identified as having competitive potential to win medals in international and World competition, based on the results from the 2025 U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships and the results from the 2024-2025 international competition season.

Team A

- 2025 U.S. senior synchronized skating champions
- Overall Medalists (top 3), at the 2025 World Synchronized Skating Championships

Team B

- 2025 U.S. senior silver medalists
- 2025 U.S. junior synchronized skating champions
- Overall Medalists (top 3), at the 2025 World Junior Synchronized Championships

Team C

- 2025 U.S. senior bronze medalists
- 2025 U.S. junior silver medalists

The Synchronized International Subcommittee will consider teams for placement in a higher Envelope as well as determine the number of any additional teams for the Team Envelope based on performance at the U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships, strength of the competition at the U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships, and the results from the 2024-25 international competition season.

Please note: The Team Envelope does not guarantee a team will be placed in the International Selection Pool (ISP) or receive an invitation to compete at an international competition.
