



1. Go to: <https://safesport.org/> and click "Sign In".




2. Enter your email address and password. If you can't remember your password, click "Forgot Password" to initiate a password reset.


3. Click the person icon in the far-right corner, then select "Update Account" from the drop-down menu.




4. Click the "Profile" tab.




