The session will include:

- What is a Music Coordinator and Announcer?
- The general process to get an appointment
- We will split into 2 groups
- Announcers
 - The Basics- Definitions, Material to be announced, source of assignments
 - The Event- Preparation and Protocol, Teamwork, Execution
 - The Mechanics- Equipment, Conduct, Facilities, Keys to success
- Music Coordinators
 - Review of the roll, and protocols
 - Review of cable technology
 - Review of typical arena hook ups
 - Review of audio mixers, both from a U.S. Figure Skating kit and from a Tri-State kit
 - Review of the typical hookup for a competition, CD players, Computers etc.
- Afternoon session will have multiple kits available for the people attending in person to setup and connect to several simulated arena connections.
