- *Josephine Lee is skating at the Pacific Coast Sectional Singles Final. She will advance regardless of her placement and will not displace a qualifier from this section to the U.S. Championships.*

SINGLES: 12 skaters per level

Top 4 athletes per section, per level in juvenile, intermediate and novice*

PAIRS: 9 teams overall

Top 6 teams from the U.S. Pairs Final in novice*

Plus, 3 additional teams (juvenile – novice) per criteria approved by the Pairs Development and Technical Committee (emphasis placed on skating skills, side-by-side jumps, and potential future international selection.) Invited pairs teams must attend as a team and not individuals.

ICE DANCE: 9 teams per level

Top 9 teams per level from the U.S. Ice Dance Final in juvenile, intermediate and novice*

** The top 2 novice men and women from each section, top five novice ice dance teams and top four novice pairs teams at the November Finals will be invited to compete at the 2024 U.S. Figure Skating Championships. As the camp schedule would require additional expenses and time away, these novice athletes/teams competing at U.S. Championships are not required to attend camp and will not be penalized in any way should they choose to not attend. Any novice athlete/team competing at U.S. Championships and not attending camp will still be a part of the 2024 High Performance National Development Team and will be able to purchase a team jacket.*

HPNDC alternates will be invited at the discretion of U.S. Figure Skating's High Performance Department. All notification will be managed via email.

What is High Performance National Development Camp?

High Performance National Development Camp (HPNDC) is hosted annually by U.S. Figure Skating, the National Governing Body for figure skating in the United States, and is the premier program for Juvenile, Intermediate, and Novice athletes. HPNDC gives athletes the opportunity to learn and interact with National and International officials; demonstrate to U.S. Figure Skating their mastery of technical elements, program components, and skills-in-progress for the upcoming season and beyond; and learn from a vast array of leading professionals in the sport. U.S. Figure Skating will use their observations at NDC to inform selection committees for future Domestic and International opportunities.

What does it mean to be part of the National Development Team?

Qualifying for the National Development Team is a great accomplishment! Being a member of the National Development team identifies each athlete as one of the top developing athletes in their discipline. This puts you on the radar for becoming a future Team USA member and to someday represent the United States of America in international competition.
