Q Who is required to complete a background check and who pays for it?

The individuals listed in the chart below are required to complete a background check via U.S. Figure Skating's partnership with NCSI. Who covers the cost varies based on a person's capacity with U.S. Figure Skating. Please see the chart below:

What changes were made to U.S. Figure Skating's background checks?

I have a current U.S. Figure Skating background check that is valid until June 2020. Do I need to submit a new one based on the changes to the screens?

No. Individuals with a current background check are not affected by these changes until the 2020-21 season compliance period which begins 6/1/2020.

What about foreign coaches or foreign officials at non-qualifying events who are not U.S. Figure Skating members?

A They will be required to present the LOC with a letter from their Federation verifying they are a member in good standing with their Federation.

Q Can I submit my background check and do my SafeSport training on paper?

A No. Both rely on very large data bases to verify information and share your compliancy. Please ask a family member or friend to assist you on their personal computer or perhaps on a computer at the library. You can also contact your club's SafeSport Chair who may find a member volunteer to help.

Q I'm an announcer/I facilitate the music at our club's non-qualifying competition. Do I need to be SafeSport compliant?

A No. Only those in a position of authority or in regular contact with athletes must comply. However, announcers/music positions at the U.S. Championships and ISU events hosted by U.S. Figure Skating are considered "officials" and therefore must be compliant.

My employer requires a background check and I also have one as a baseball coach. Can I submit one of those?

A No. The background check U.S. Figure Skating requires is specific to U.S. Figure Skating and must be completed through your U.S. Figure Skating Members Only portal. We do not accept any other screenings.

Q How often do I need to do the SafeSport training and background check?

A U.S. Figure Skating has moved to bi-annual background checks. Background checks submitted on or after 1/1/2020 will be valid for the season in which it is completed, plus the following season.

Beginning 6/1/2020, the SafeSport training will be an annual requirement.

Q What calendar is being used for compliance?

A Compliancy will follow the U.S. Figure Skating membership year which begins July 1 and ends June 30.

Q After I complete my SafeSport training and background check, how long will it take to show I'm compliant?

A It takes 5-10 business days for NCSI to complete a domestic background check. International screens may take up to 14 days to be complete. Once U.S. Figure Skating is notified, it takes one business day or less for a person's compliance status to be updated.

Q What if I choose not to complete the SafeSport training and background check?

A You will not be permitted to participate in a role that requires compliance.

Who is responsible for making sure individuals at events are compliant?

A It is the responsibility of both the individual who is required to be compliant and the Local Organizing Committee who is running the event.

What about foreign coaches or foreign officials at non-qualifying events who are not U.S. Figure Skating members?

A They will be required to present the LOC with a letter from their Federation verifying they are a member in good
