Reporting to the Chief Technology Officer, the Senior Manager, Software Development serves as the Development Lead and DevOps Lead of U.S. Figure Skating's home-grown software applications, for example, the Event Management System, Membership Management System, and Learn to Skate USA. The Senior Manager, Software Development needs to have an ownership mentality with strong hands-on experience in software development and DevOps. The Senior Manager, Software Development is responsible for managing the development team to deliver the features and functionalities specified in the requirement documents on time and on budget.

Description and Responsibilities Include:

- Lead the development and maintenance of the U.S. Figure Skating applications and platform.
- Manage 5 to 7 developers and be fully responsible for their performance and delivery including reviewing the code, providing coaching, resolving conflicts, and blocking dependencies.
- Execute project plans and deliver commitments within a professional, high paced development environment.
- Interface with U.S. Figure Skating internal business stakeholders and external customers to understand requirements, set priorities, and communicate direction and progress.
- Participate in designing, coding, testing, debugging, configuring, and/or documenting software when needed.
- Serve as the DevOps lead to drive the automation and to build, deploy and monitor software projects continuously with CI/CD.
- Ensure software quality and reliability objectives are met through manual/automated testing, unit testing, code reviews and other tools and processes.
- Mentor team to help advance their technical and analytical skills and lead by example.
- Provide technical guidance and leading practices to members of the team.
- Collaborate with senior leaders on product vision and technical strategy.

- Two years' experiences as a hands-on software development manager or lead
- A minimum of 5 years' experience as an application developer
