Description and Responsibilities Include:

- Supporting the Manager, Video Content and Manager, Video Production on site at U.S. Figure Skating events. This includes capturing video content for cross platform usage, helping set up and breakdown video and audio equipment, managing media and media delivery and producing quick turnaround edits.
- Managing footage deliveries, broadcast uploads and overall media organization.
- Editing video content using in app editing (i.e., TikTok, IG), as well as Adobe Premiere.
- Working in a collaborative environment within the Marketing department to help develop video strategies and ensure that all videos are on brand and aligned with U.S. Figure Skating goals.
- Collaborating with the Communications department to capture and deliver social content that will inspire established members while also bringing new interest and excitement to the sport.
- Performing regular video editing duties, such as importing and organizing footage, creating projects, color grading, sound mixing and exporting videos in various formats for rightsholders.

Qualifications:

- Applicant should hold a bachelor's preferably in videography, video production, marketing or communications. In the absence of related degree, a strong video production portfolio will suffice.
- Must have a strong working knowledge of current and emerging AV equipment (DSLRs, audio equipment, set studios)
- Applicant should be a creative problem solver and analytical thinker
- Experience with cross platform, IP enabled video services and applications
- Proficiency in Adobe Creative Suite and After Effects, with knowledge of in app editing (specifically with Reels and TikTok)
- Understanding of user generated content and video production
- Understanding of deliverables across multiple platforms and aspect ratios
- Knowledge in evolving video technologies
- Knowledge of functions and related tasks in the area of video content
- Working knowledge of motion graphics is a plus but not required
