COACH PROFILE	Coach Profile – Start by building your profile that will appear attached to your <u>Members</u> <u>Only</u> account, after you purchase your Coach I.C.E. membership. Construct a digital resume featuring your expertise and accomplishments to showcase to current and potential students. The information you input will be output to the Coach Directory. See "Tips for Building Your Coach Profile."
COACH COMPLIANCE	Coach compliance pieces will be launched from <u>Members Only</u> . Initiate your background check (included), U.S. Center of SafeSport Training, liability insurance, waivers and the new Coaching Standards of Professionalism.
COACH DIRECTORY	Coach Directory – A new <u>Members Only</u> feature coming June 1. All certified, compliant Coach I.C.E. members will have a profile in this searchable directory. It will display the coaching expertise of all coaches and is available to all U.S. Figure Skating and Learn to Skate USA members. You control what goes in the Coach Directory through your Coach Profile and may update it at any time.
STANDARDS OF PROFESSIONALISM	The Coaching Standards of Professionalism outlines the expectations of all figure skating coaches. These standards are supported by the U.S. Figure Skating SkateSafe/Legal Department and Ethics and Professional Standards Committee.

COACHCONNECT LIVE!	<ul> <li>Save the Date! <i>CoachConnect Live</i> offers Coach I.C.E. members discounted all-session tickets to major U.S. Figure Skating events. These tickets include practice passes and guided observation. COACH THE FUTURE MENTORING	<ul> <li>For competitive coaches that are looking to take their experience to the next level, Coach the Future Mentoring will be held in conjunction with a Sectional Singles Final and the U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships.</li> <li>Coaches will attend the entire event, view all practice and competition events, and have in-depth conversations with mentor coaches and officials. An application and criteria will be required.</li> <li>Eastern Sectional Singles &amp; U.S. Pairs Final – Nov. 13-17, 2024 – Norwood, Mass.</li> <li>U.S. Synchronized Skating Championships – Feb. 27 – March 1, 2025 - Colorado Springs, Colo.</li> </ul>
LEVEL 1 ACCREDITATION	For all coaches who did not earn a PSA rating before June 30, 2024, U.S. Figure Skating will open Accreditation Level 1 in the winter of 2025. Accreditation Level 1 will be discipline-specific and fully online to be as accessible to as many coaches as possible.
LEVEL 2 ACCREDITATION	U.S. Figure Skating Level 2 accreditations will be available beginning in the summer of 2025. In the meantime, this accreditation level will be available through the previous system of PSA ratings. Information will be provided in the U.S. Figure Skating coach newsletter.
SENIOR AND MASTER ACCREDITATION	U.S. Figure Skating Senior and Master accreditations are planned for the 2026 and 2027 seasons. In the meantime, coaches already in the pipeline through their PSA ratings will be able to take these accreditation levels through the previous system of ratings.





Public acknowledgement and celebration of quality coaching and achievements.

	U.S. Figure Skating is creating a new set of awards open to all members of Coach I.C.E. Winners of these awards will be announced after the conclusion of the 2025 competitive season, with public recognition to all winners.
	Criteria and specifics will be announced to Coach I.C.E. members in October 2024.
AWARDS	Awards are set to recognize:
	<ul> <li>The five values of U.S. Figure Skating – excellence, integrity, respect, resilience, and community, with both performance and character criteria.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Additional awards will recognize up-and-coming coaches, as well as traditional awards such as Coach of the Year, Choreographer of the Year and USOPC awards.</li> </ul>
U.S. FIGURE SKATING AWARDS	Coaches will be recognized publicly and regularly to U.S. Figure Skating membership though SKATING magazine, social media, newsletters, etc.



Provide a voice and representation within U.S. Figure Skating.

	The current U.S. Figure Skating Coaches Council was appointed by the U.S. Figure Skating Board of Directors in the fall of 2023. These individuals will serve through the conclusion of the 2025 Governing Council. The Coaches Council for the 2025-26 season will be elected by Coach I.C.E members. All compliant members are eligible to vote and serve.
COACHES COUNCIL	<ul><li>Timeline:</li><li>February 2025: Applications to serve will be made available.</li></ul>
	<ul> <li>March 2025: Coaches submit applications, and applications are reviewed.</li> </ul>
	April 2025: Election is held.
	• May 2025: The 2025-26 Coaches Council members will be announced, with a term starting June 1, 2025.
	<b>NOTE:</b> The current Coaches Council members will serve as coach delegates at the 2025 U.S. Figure Skating Governing Council. Coach delegates receive a collective one vote per 50 registered Coach I.C.E. members. Votes are divided evenly between the 27 members.
